The Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited (TSCL) invites ***Request for Proposal*** in **Two cover system** from Reputed Outdoor Advertising Firms for the work of **“PROVIDING 34 ELECTRONIC DISPLAY BOARDS WITH AIR QUALITY MONITORING SYSTEMS INCLUDING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AGAINST COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENT RIGHTS ON DBOT BASIS”**.

The Scope of the work is to provide Digital ELECTRONIC Display Boards including operation and maintenance of the same against commercial advertisement rights on DBOT Basis within the Corporation Limits. The interested bidding firms should necessarily furnish the information indicating their qualifications along with their credentials in proof of their experience.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1) The bidders are advised to read the RFP documents carefully before bidding. The terms and conditions mentioned in the RFP documents will carry the meaning as assigned to them. In case of any dispute on any of the terms and conditions, the decision of the Managing Director, TSCL will be the final and binding on the bidders.
- 2) The Managing Director, TSCL reserves the right to alter or modify the terms and conditions of the bid at any time without notice.
- 3) The Bids should be submitted in **two covers i.e. technical and financial**. The first bid cover (cover-1) will consist of the EMD and a technical bid without any reference to prices and the second bid cover (cover-2) will consist of their financial bid only. The Financial bids should be submitted in the format prescribed in the bid document. The Financial bids submitted in any other format will be summarily rejected.
- 4) Conditional offers will be summarily rejected.
- 5) The bidders are advised to visit the site of development for which they are tendering to assess the work to be executed and the revenue realization expected from advertisement on the packages. It is presumed that the bidders have quoted with the full knowledge of the work to be carried out and other obligations the tenderer should discharge. No correspondence in this behalf will be entertained
- 6) The bidder should remit an amount of **Rs.10.00 Lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) as Earnest Money Deposit** in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalised/Schedule banks drawn in favour of "The Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited, Tiruppur" along with the bid.
- 7) The successful bidder should enter into an agreement with the TSCL within 15 days from the date of issue of letter of acceptance failing which the Bid security paid by the bidder will be forfeited. The Managing Director, TSCL will have all

powers to cancel the tender and re-tenders will be called for as per the decision of the Managing Director.

- 8) The space provided for display of advertisement boards shall be as provided by TSCL.
- 9) The TSCL reserves the right to remove any display boards whenever found objectionable.
- 10) The successful bidder shall not transfer his right or business interests to any person or persons or concerns. Else the bid will be cancelled and the Bid Security will be forfeited.
- 11) The Managing Director, TSCL reserves the right to cancel the contract without giving any notice if the bidder fails to abide by the contract conditions. In the event of such cancellation of contract, the Managing Director, TSCL or the Officer authorized by him will have every right to take action as mentioned in the above conditions.
- 12) If any doubt arises with regard to any of the conditions mentioned, the decision of the Managing Director, TSCL will be final and the bidder should abide by the same.
- 13) The successful bidder should necessarily obtain the required structural stability certificate for every digital display board & structure erected on from the Competent Authority within 15 days after erection.
- 14) The successful Bidder shall be responsible for any injury/damage/loss to the public by the structures erected. The bidder shall pay the necessary damages as per relevant provisions of law.
- 15) The bidder may insure the all digital display boards to ensure safety, security for boards as well as to the general public.
- 16) The **Period for erection** of all the structures will be **two months (60 days)** from the date of Letter of award.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Background:

Tiruppur popularly known as 'The Manchester of South India' is the district headquarters of Tiruppur district. It is the third largest city in TamilNadu and houses numerous textile mills and small scale engineering units. The city is well connected to its region by rail, road and air. It is a major junction on the Madras-Palghat Broad Gauge section and the NH 47 runs through the center of the city. A domestic airport in the city links it with all major cities of the country.

Besides, other principal arterials radiate from the center of the city leading to places like Perur, Maruthamalai and Thadagam. A network of railway lines exists in the city leading to Mettupalyam in the North, Erode in the East and Pollachi in the South.

TSCL wants to install 'Air Quality Monitoring Systems' at 30 different locations across the city. They record air quality parameters (measure concentration of particulate matter – PM 10 & PM 2.5 in the atmosphere) and noise level round the clock. To disseminate climate conditions of the city with pollution level, humidity, Noise level etc., and public service messages and information about Government/ Municipal Corporation schemes, Emergency Announcements etc., to the general public, Tiruppur Smart City Limited (TSCL) intends to install Electronic Display Boards.

The TSCL invites Request for Proposal in Two cover system from interested persons/firms for the work of **“PROVIDING 34 ELECTRONIC DISPLAY BOARDS WITH AIR QUALITY MONITORING SYSTEMS INCLUDING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AGAINST COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENT RIGHTS ON DBOT BASIS”**.

1.0 Scope of the Work:

The scope of work under this contract is for **PROVIDING 34 ELECTRONIC DISPLAY BOARDS WITH AIR QUALITY MONITORING SYSTEMS INCLUDING OPERATION AND**

MAINTENANCE AGAINST COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENT RIGHTS ON DBOT BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF 15 YEARS.

The following specifications are to be adhered:

1. The Bidder has to install the ELECTRONIC Display Boards with Air Quality Monitoring Systems.
2. 20% of display area should be earmarked for continuous display of Air Quality data prominently.
3. Balance 80% display area may be used by the bidder to display advertisement.
4. In the 80% display available for advertisement at least 2 minutes in every slot of 10 minutes should be used for display of public messages promoted by TCMC / TSCL / GTN /GOI/ District administration.

2.0 Tender Process in Brief:

- 2.1 The Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited, Tiruppur invites tenders in **Two Cover system** for the work of “PROVIDING 34 ELECTRONIC DISPLAY BOARDS WITH AIR QUALITY MONITORING SYSTEMS INCLUDING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AGAINST COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENT RIGHTS ON DBOT BASIS”. **The bids will be received upto 3.00 PM on or before 31.08.2020. The Technical Proposals contained in the tender will be opened on 31.08.2020 at 3.30 PM** itself in the presence of bidders (or) the persons authorized by the bidders who choose to be present. The bidding documents can be downloaded free of cost from the Corporation website namely www.tntender.gov.in
- 2.2 The bid should accompany a **Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only)** which should be remitted only by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited, Tiruppur”. The Bid security deposit remitted in any other form other than Demand Draft will not be accepted and such bids will be summarily rejected.

2.3 Bids must reach the office of the Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited, Tiruppur-641601 **on or before 31.08.2020 (3:00 PM). The First Cover containing the Technical Bids will be opened on 31.08.2020 at 3.30 PM** itself in the presence of bidders (or) the persons authorized by the bidders who choose to be present.

2.4 The terms used in this RFP document which have not been defined herein, shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the draft Agreement.

2.5 Pre-bid Meeting :

A Pre-bid meeting in this regard will be held on **21.08.2020 @ 11:00 AM** at the Conference Hall of the Corporation Main Office.

3.0 Schedule of Events:

3.1 The application forms will be available for download from **25.07.2020 onwards till 30.08.2020.**

3.2 The TSCL would endeavor to adhere to the following schedule:

4.0 Eligibility Criteria:

4.1 This invitation for submission of RFP is an open bid/tender and any business entity that fulfills the following Eligibility Criteria can alone participate in this bid.

4.2 The bidding firm/company/joint venture of limited companies must have achieved Minimum annual financial turnover of Rs.50.00 Crores for each of the preceding three (3) years. In the case of Joint Venture, any one of the

partners' individual turnover must be more than Rs.50.00 Crores for each of the preceding three (3) years.

- 4.3 The bidding firm/company/joint venture must have minimum experience in the field of advertisings or steel fabrication for a single contract value or gross realization of revenue from a single client of more than Rs. 2.00 Crores in any two (2) years of the preceding three (3) financial years. In the case of Joint Venture, any one of the partners' individual single client of more than Rs. 2.00 Crores in any two years of the preceding three financial years.
- 4.4 The bidder must have undertaken one corridor project work involving providing foot path with greenery or erection of street furniture in government agencies in anyone of the last 3 financial years including the current financial year for an worth Rs. 2.00 Crores. In proof thereof notarized copies of the work orders / Letter of concert issued by the concern department of agency should be enclosed along with their bids.
- 4.5 If the bidding firm/company/joint venture is a Subsidiary of any company of Indian origin, then the bidding company can submit the experience of the parent company along with a certificate of undertaking from the parent company certifying such experience. However, financial information acceptable for evaluation shall be that of the bidding company.
- 4.6 If the bidding firm/company/joint venture is a parent company of India origin, then it can also submit the experience of subsidiary company. Financial information acceptable for evaluation shall be that partner company only.
- 4.7 If the bidding firm/company/joint venture is a subsidiary of any company of Indian origin, then the bidding company can submit the experience and financial information of the parent company for evaluation along with a certificate of undertaking of accepting joint liability in all cases.

- 4.8 In case of joint venture bidders, financial information acceptable for evaluation shall be that of the identified partner in the “JV” which shall be clearly indicated by the JV Bidder. Experience information acceptable for evaluation shall be the individual experience of the JV partners. However, a lead partner in the JV shall be specified. No joint venture arrangement shall be permitted after submission of bids.

5.0 Qualification Criteria

i Financial Information

Evaluation will be based on the basis of following criteria.

a. Annual Turnover

The bidding Firm/Company/Joint Venture of limited companies shall have achieved a minimum annual Financial turnover of Rs. 50.00 Crores (Indian Rupees Fifty Crores Only) for each of the preceding three (3) years.

In case of Joint Venture any one of the partners' individual turnover must be more than Rs. 50.00 Crores for each of the preceding three (3) years.

ii Experience Information

The bidding Firms/Company/Joint Venture must have minimum experience in the field of advertisings or in steel fabrication for a single contract value or gross realization of revenue from a single client of more than Rs.2.00 Crores in any two (2) years over the preceding three (3) financial years. In the case of Joint Venture, any one of the partners' individual single contract value or gross realization of revenue from a single client of more than Rs.2.00 Crores in any two years of the preceding three financial years.

In case of Firms/Company/Joint Venture involved in above line value of this purpose shall also mean gross realization of revenue from a single client in the single financial year. Gross realization shall be submitted in the form of a

consolidated statement clearly indicating at a minimum the invoice / bill number, date, client name, gross value and date of realization. The consolidated statement shall be duly certified by the Chartered Accountant and accompanied by all supporting documents.

Qualification of a bidding firm/company/joint venture to participate further in the selection process would depend upon its meeting the general eligibility and qualification criteria mentioned above.

6.0 Qualification Submission, Evaluation of the Technical & Financial Bids:

- 6.1 This invitation of bids is for 34 locations.
- 6.2 The bidders should submit their bids in two cover system. The first Cover should contain the Technical Proposals only along with the demand draft towards Bid Security Deposit, the requisite Documentary evidences prescribed in **Clause (5.0)** of this bid document and the Second Cover should contain the Financial Bid which should be in sealed condition. Both the Covers should be put in a separate Outer cover and then submitted.
- 6.3 The Technical bids of the bidders will be evaluated by the Tender Scrutiny Committee constituted for this purpose based on the Technical, Financial capabilities, Previous experience, the eligibility criteria as prescribed in **Clause (5.0)**. Thereafter, the financial bids of those technically qualified bidders will be evaluated. The date of opening of the financial bids will be intimated to the qualifying bidders.
- 6.4 The bidders who are technically responsive will only be considered for the next stage of evaluation i.e. opening of the financial bids.
- 6.5 In the event of one or more bidders happen to quote their highest amount, the same will be decided separately. In such cases, the bidders will be required to give their offer in a separate format immediately during the same day of opening of the financial bid cover. It shall be noted that the new rate offered by the bidders should not be less than the one already quoted by them in the previous bid. Even when the bids are again same, the draw will finalise the bidder.
- 6.6 The bid will be finalized based on the amount quoted. Failure

to comply with these criteria will result in rejection of the Financial Bid. The Evaluation of financial bid will be based on the maximum license fee per annum as assessed by the TSCL.

7.0 Project Inspections and visit to the site of work:

- 7.1 The bidders may carry out the project inspection of the designated display board locations at any time at their cost.
- 7.2 It is desirable that each bidder submits its proposal after visiting the site and ascertaining for themselves the location, surroundings or any other matter considered relevant to it.
- 7.3 It would be deemed that by submitting the RFP, the bidder has:
 - a) made a complete and careful examination of terms & conditions/ requirements, and other information set forth in the RFP document.
 - b) received all such relevant information as requested from the TSCL and
 - c) made a complete and careful examination of the various aspects of the project including, but not limited to:
 - (i) Condition of sites; and
 - (ii) All other matters that might affect the bidder's performance under the terms of this RFP document.

The TSCL shall not be liable for any mistake or error on the part of the bidder in respect of the above notification.

8.0 Clarifications

9.0 The **validity** of the offer quoted in the tender will be for **90 days** from the date of opening the tender which can be extended for a specific period on the request of the TSCL.

But extending the validity is binding on the bidder on request from the TSCL.

10.0 The successful bidder should execute the agreement within 7 days from the date of acceptance of the tender. Failure to execute the agreement will entitle forfeiture of the Bid Security. The expenses incurred in this regard for executing the agreement shall be borne by the successful bidder.

11.0 The following documents shall be part of the agreement to be entered into with the successful bidder.

- a. Notice inviting Request for Proposal (RFP)
- b. Instructions to Bidders
- c. General Conditions
- d. Minutes of the Pre bid meeting
- e. Financial bid
- f. Technical Specifications and Drawings of the proposed structure to hold the digital display boards
- g. Any other drawings furnished by the TSCL for execution of civil work specifications.
- h. The Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Licensing of Hoardings and Levy and Collection of Advertisement Tax Rules, 2003.

12.0 Authorized signatory of the firms other than those owned individually is the person authorized to sign the tender documents and agreements. In doing so the signatory should produce the power of attorney from the firm.

13.0 The work of development should be taken up within 15 days from the date of signing of the agreement and inform the appropriate authority of the TSCL for having started the work. If the successful bidder fails to start the work as per the stipulated period, his agreement is liable for cancellation and forfeiture of the Bid security Amount and other deposits made by him and liable to be black listed.

- 14.0 The bidder should have not been Black listed or debarred by the TSCL or any ULB or any District Administration or other Government Agency in the past years for any reasons whatsoever. If at a later stage it is found that the bidder had been Black Listed or debarred the Contract Agreement/License Agreement will be terminated/cancelled with forfeiture of the Bid security deposit.
- 15.0 The site will be provided on as is where basis is.
- 16.0 The successful bidder should get a certificate from the TSCL regarding unsuitable locations due to all reasons immediately after requisition and Joint Inspection of the TSCL officials and the Bidder.
- 17.0 The successful bidder should get completion certificate from the TSCL on requisition as and when erection works completed regularly within stipulated time immediately.
- 18.0 The successful bidder should obtain the completion certificate as soon as digital display board works are completed from the TSCL.
- 19.0 Any disputes that may arise during the tenure of agreement should be got settled mutually by both the parties within the jurisdiction of Tiruppur City. If the dispute is not settled mutually then the matter will be referred to the **Arbitration Committee** formed by the District Collector for this purpose.
- 20.0 The bidder should furnish the details of litigation history of the firm in the form provided for this purpose in this bid document.
- 21.0 The successful bidder should pay the advertisement tax in advance for 12 months within seven days from the date of acceptance of the bid.
- 22.0 The Bid security Amount of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the completion of all the bidding process. However, in the case of the successful bidders, the bid security amount will be refunded only after satisfactory completion of the maintenance period including extensions if any granted to the bidder.

23.0 The Managing Director, TSCL reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal or call for negotiations/re-tender without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The rates should be quoted both in words and figures. If any discrepancy found in the rates quoted in words and figures, highest of above will prevail and no requests for downward revision will be entertained.
2. The bidder should submit the programme of development and maintenance of digital display boards along with the tender document.
3. The bidder to arrange for power supply for AQM and Display Board with servers (both hardware and software) including CAPEX and OPEX.
4. Bidder to pay monthly electricity charges, data charges for AQM and Electronic display boards directly to TANGEDCO.
5. Bidder to maintain the AQM's and Electronic Display Board installed.
6. All the equipment's and manpower to be insured as per the prevailing regulations.
7. The successful bidder to remit an amount equaling to 50% of the annual fee quoted in form of DD drawn in favour of Managing Director, Tiruppur Smart City Limited payable at Tiruppur towards security deposit.
8. The successful bidder is required to enter into agreement as per the time stipulations referred in these documents elsewhere.
9. The successful bidder will be permitted to erect advertisement boards on developed and erected by them as

per the Guidelines of the Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Licensing of Hoardings and Levy and Collection of Advertisement tax Rules, 2003 in force.

10. The successful bidder should pay in advance for the ensuing financial years License fee (quoted by them in the Financial Bid) and the advertisement tax, Cesses and other statutory levies as applicable under the Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Licensing of Hoardings and Levy and Collection of Advertisement tax Rules, 2003 in force.
11. The License fee during the 2nd year of license period will be increased at an annual rate of 5% without any compounding. To clarify this, this license amount during the 2nd year will be the 1st years lease amount + 5% increase and during the 3rd year it will be the Second years lease amount + 5% increase of 1st year lease amount and so on.
12. The bidder should remit the yearly License amount 10 days before the due date for remittance every year.
13. The successful bidder shall obtain all the required Licenses, Permits and NOC's from the authorities concerned (Highways, CCMC, Police, District Administration etc.,) at their own cost in respect of erection of Advertisement boards. However the TSCL will facilitate the bidder to obtain all such approvals from the authorities concerned.
14. The licensee shall display name and logo of the TSCL etc., prominently in both Tamil & English Languages above the front advertisement panel.
15. In the event of any requirement additional boards at the locations identified by the TSCL, the size/area of the advertisement display boards will be proportionately decided by the TSCL.
16. The following items of beautification shall be part of the maintenance plan:
 - (i) Forthwith repair the display boards or any part thereof

upon any damage, loss, breakage being noticed or reported or occurring and reconstruct when repair is not feasible/ sufficient to present a satisfactory condition.

- (ii) Arrange security to protect the digital display boards together with all amenities, fixtures, advertisements, etc against vandalism.
17. The successful bidder should obtain the completion certificate from the TSCL as soon as works are completed.
 18. All installations including electrical fittings and other fixtures shall be the property of the TSCL. Therefore, the licensee should furnish an inventory of all the infrastructure created within 60 days of installation and should handover all infrastructures as per the inventory furnished after the completion of period of agreement.
 19. In the event of default in completion of the work, the following penalty will be imposed for not adhering to the time schedule

Deviations, sub-standard work etc.,

- a) First Violation : Rs.10,000/- fine per location with first extended time of 30 days.
- b) Second Violation : Rs.20,000/- fine per location with first extended time of 30 days.

Cancellation of license will be effected if the rectification is not completed within 60 days of extension. No refund of Security deposit and license fee is admissible for cancellation of license.

20. Sub-letting the license granted to successful tendered in any manner is not permissible and shall entitle cancellation of the license.
21. The licensee shall be responsible for any damage caused to the property of the TSCL or for the injuries caused to persons during development or maintenance period and the licensee should make good the losses caused on the TSCL property or the life of persons either the citizens or his own staff during

the period of development and maintenance.

22. The TSCL reserves the right to demand the licensor under exceptional circumstances to advertise the Government advertisements or TSCL advertisements for a period not exceeding 15 days in a year for social messages or during special events.
23. Any change in the concept plan, specification, drawings etc., shall be with the explicit approval and written orders of the Managing Director. Any order issued by any of the officer without the explicit permission of the Managing Director shall be null and void.
24. The sole Commercials Publicity rights would mean that the successful bidder will only have the right to put advertisement in any form at the awarded locations.
25. Advertisements pertaining to liquor, obscenity, tobacco and any other subject/item considered objectionable under various Acts and Laws of the Government shall not be displayed. The Licensee shall be fully liable for any contravention to the various state and statutory laws relating to Advertisement/Display of items.
26. The licensee will have advertisement rights confined only to the area licensed out to him for display of publicity under the contract.
27. Advertisements should not interfere / obstruct the signage boards already displayed.
28. The entire advertising materials etc. shall be installed and maintained throughout the currency of the contract by the tenderer at his/their own cost. Administration will not responsible for loss or damage or theft to any of the advertising material.
29. The Administration reserves the right to remove any advertisement for the purpose of painting or repair of the space given for advertisement or to direct the tenderer to shift the advertisements to another place, if necessary to do so and it would be without any compensation.

30. The Advertise(s) may display his/their name and contractual period at the bottom of the material.
31. Any failure on the part of the tenderer in clearing the dues within the stipulated time will result in cancellation of the contract forthwith and advertising material will be confiscated. The tenderer shall indemnify the TSCL/TCMC against loss/damage to TSCL/TCMC property as well as any claim for loss or injury caused to any member of the public or employee of TSCL/TCMC arising out negligence or misconduct on the part of the tenders because of improper placement of material/ fitting of any advertising material.
32. Advertisements creating public nuisance, nudity, or other such pictures, posters or any other means of advertisements which may hinder the sight of public should not be allowed.
33. The bidder can display any other advertisement boards which will contain National messages useful to the general public as and when required with the permission of the TSCL.
34. Slogans, sayings which contain inoffensive remarks on any caste, creed, community and persons of any origin should not be displayed.
35. Advertisements from banned organizations should not be exhibited.

37. Slogans affecting the Integrity of the Nation in any means are totally prohibited.
